

The University of Bonn cooperates closely with three Georgian universities: Tbilisi State University (Physics and Political Science), Tbilisi State Medical University (Human Medicine/Global Health) and Ilia State University (Biology). Two new scholarship projects have been secured in collaboration with the latter two in 2022 via the Erasmus+Worldwide Exchange Programme. In order to strengthen and further develop these partnerships, the University of Bonn is inviting eight researchers from Georgia and Armenia to Bonn, funded by the German Ministry of Education and Research (BMBF) through the Developing Higher Education
